Suggested <u>Project Categories</u>: Astronomy (Planets, Space, Sky Watching), Life Science (Living Things, Animals, Photosynthesis), Earth Science (Minerals, Geology, Fossils), Chemistry (Energy), Biology, Physics, Environment, Health, Communicating Science, Technology, Agriculture, Engineering.

<u>Project Types</u>: 1.) Individual projects may by done with teachers or parents (as long as child participates fully every step of the way, does most of the project, and is prepared to give the report on the project). 2.) Group science projects involving 4+ students who work cooperatively on the project.
