**ILION, NY – An Ilion man was charged with grand larceny, criminal possession and impersonation following an investigation.**

According to the Oneida County District Attorney's Office, in April 2015, they began an investigation following a complaint about a hired contractor.

Over a few months, Christopher Gordon, 35, allegedly provided fraudulent documents to victims which were either forged or obtained by the defendant pretending to be a representative of a local contracting company.

The victims were charged for services and paid for material that was never ordered nor delivered.

As a result of the investigation, a search warrant was obtained and executed on a vessel in the Ilion Marina. The defendant was located there and taken into custody.

Computers and documents were seized that may be relative to the case.

Gordon was charged with one count of grand larceny in the third degree, one count of grand larceny in the fourth degree, two counts of criminal possession of a forged instrument , and one count of criminal impersonation in the second degree.
